However, it is never too late to start and you are able to begin the RAWA program when your child is within 9 months to 3 Years Old :

- **Everyday Arabic:** Integrate the Arabic words from the program into your daily routines and activities with your child.
- **Sing & Mimic:** Singing or playing RAWA songs while engaging in hand gestures (if applicable) creates a fun and interactive learning environment for infants and toddlers.
